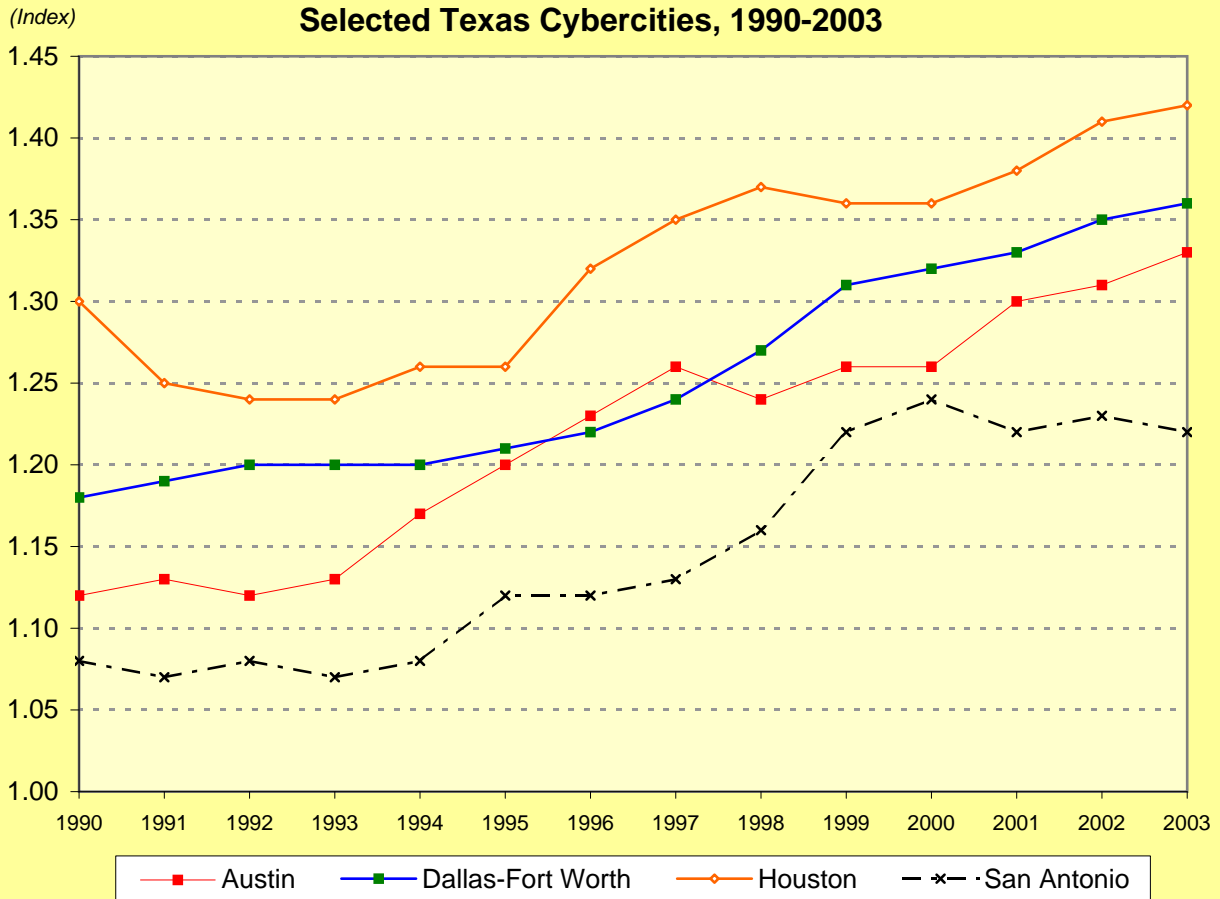


Travel Time Index, Urban Areas Within Selected Texas Cybercities, 1990-2003



Note: The Travel Time Index (TTI) is the ratio of rush hours (peak period travel time) to non-rush hours (free-flow travel time.) The TTI estimates the average amount of *extra* time it takes to travel a specific distance in rush hours compared to non-rush hours. Non-rush hour speed is estimated at 60 mph on freeways and 35 mph on major streets. Speeds less than that are an indication of delay.
