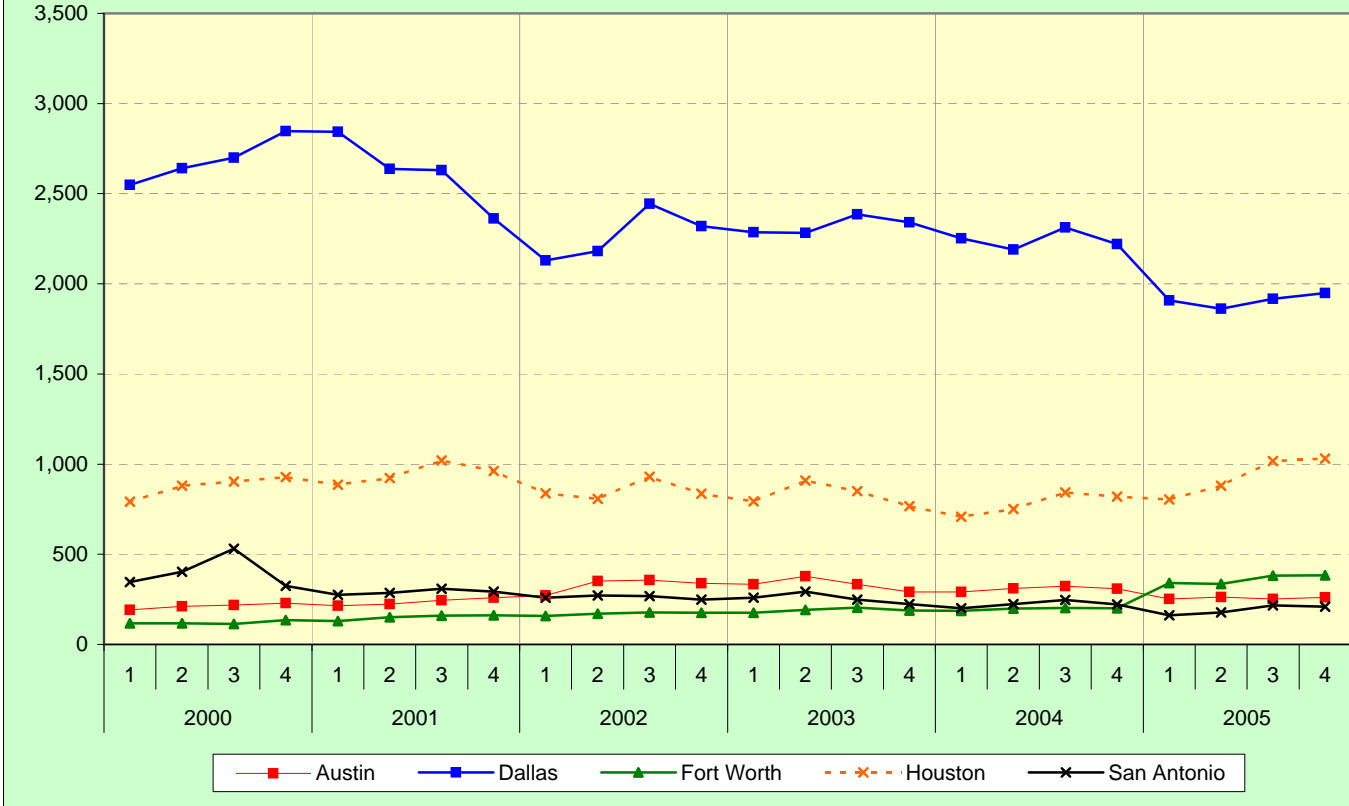


## Transportation, Communications, and Public Utilities Sales Subject to Texas Sales Tax in Selected Texas Cybercities, 2000-2005
