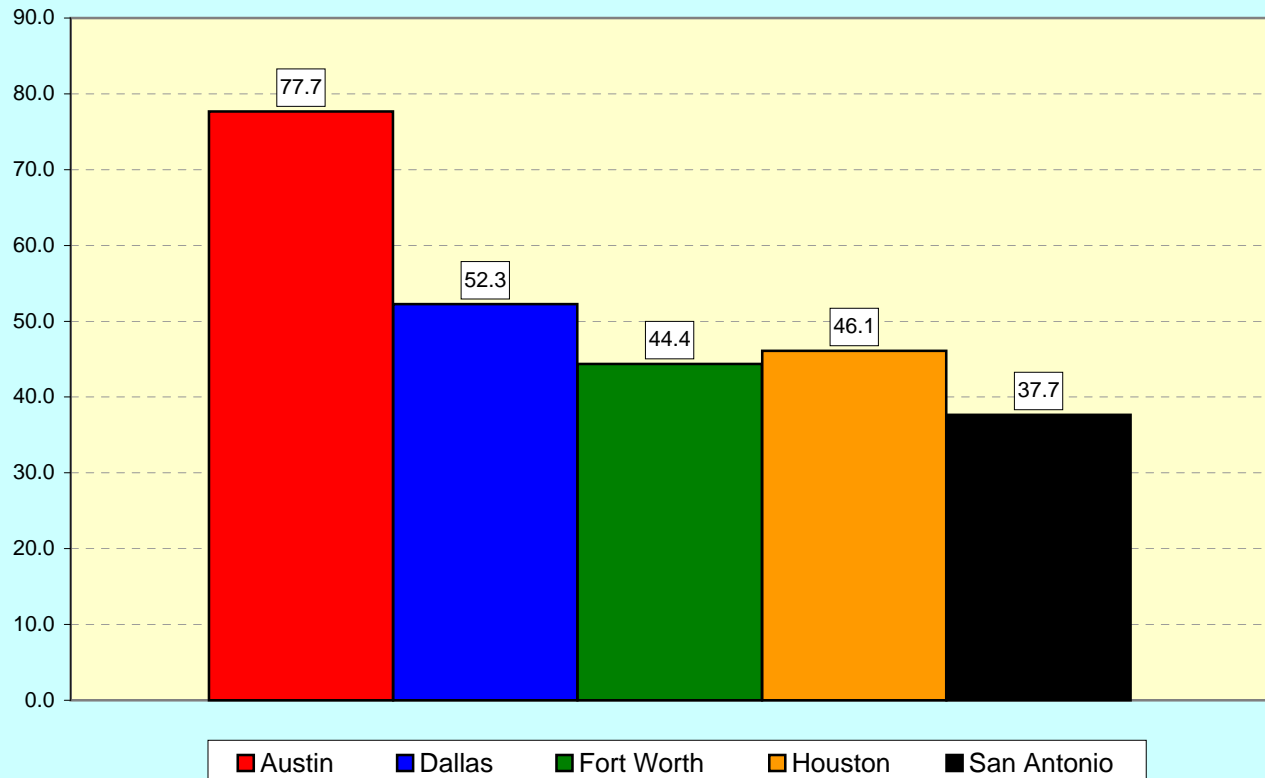


Total Percentage Change in Total Population in Selected Texas Cybercities*, 1990-2006
